Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

Holy Week & Lenten Worship: This week the school has come together to focus upon the important events of Holy Week and reflect upon the significance of these. Children from Key Stage Two led us on Monday, as we focused upon the journey that Jesus made this week, from his joyous entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, to the sharing of bread and wine during the Last Supper and his arrest and sentencing to death.
