'Neither Do I Condemn You'. John 8:1-11

This week we have reflected on last Sunday's Gospel Reading from John, one that has an important teaching that we can use to guide our lives today. The scribes and Pharisees were trying to entrap Jesus in asking His opinion on a law and rule that concerned a woman and man who had committed sin. It was the woman only, who was brought before Him and all knew that breaking the law could result in punishment of death. Jesus was placed in a difficult position to respond to this. Was He to follow the laws of Moses or to give a different response? His response was one of mercy, compassion and forgiveness. He challenges the crowds gathered,

'Let anyone who is without sin throw the first stone'.

Rather than being the one initially challenged, Jesus becomes the one in control of the situation, as one by one the Pharisees and crowds leave Jesus alone with the woman who had sinned. With tenderness and compassion for the woman, He reminds everyone that God extends mercy to all who repent and turn from their sins. We remind ourselves that we are called to be compassionate, understanding and not quick to judge the actions of others. During this Season of Lent, as we approach Holy Week, we remember that God's mercy and forgiveness knows no limits if we are truly sorry and we repent.
