Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

I write to you for the final time this term as we journey through this special Holy Week towards Easter.

Holy Week and Lenten Worship: We have come together this week, to focus and reflect upon the important events of Holy Week and the significance of these. Holy Week is a very sacred week. Not only do we remember the events of Jesus' final week on earth and His journey to the cross, but through Faith, we participate and share in them.

On Monday, children from KS2 led our whole school liturgy, as through Gospel Readings, reflection and hymns we remembered Jesus' joyous entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, hailed as the Messiah and the King who would liberate Israel. We reflected on the Last Supper, the sharing of bread and wine with His closest friends and of Jesus the Servant King, washing the feet of His disciples as an example to them and to us. His arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane and the denial of Jesus by Peter, led us to today and the Stations of Cross service that we have held this morning.

Our journey through the Stations of the Cross and reflections upon these events provide a focal point for how we can take Jesus' pain and sacrifice to shape our lives and how we treat each other.

As a school, we especially think about how we can follow Jesus in the service of others and to be messengers of peace and forgiveness during this Jubilee Year as Pilgrims of Hope.
