Welcome back after what I hope was a very restful half-term break.

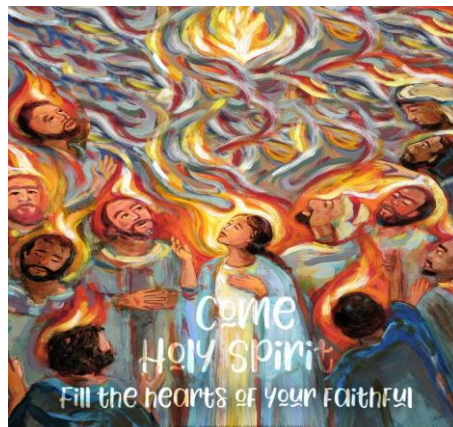
Pentecost Celebrations

In school, we have celebrated last Sunday's Feast of Pentecost. This is one of the most important feast days of the year, concluding the season of Easter and celebrating the beginning of the church.

Pentecost is the celebration of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room in Jerusalem.
