Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

The Feast of Corpus Christi – The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

In assemblies today we have reflected on last Sunday's Feast of Corpus Christi. The Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ reminds us of the importance of the Eucharist and how central this is to the life of the church, our faith and our relationship with God.

We listened to the Gospel reading from Sunday. A very familiar one that tells the story of Jesus 'Feeding the Five Thousand' one of many miraculous stories from the Gospel that describes the multiplying of food. Jesus can see that the people are hungry and He feeds them. It is a familiar theme. Jesus encounters people in distress and has compassion for them. He heals them, He feeds them, He restores them and gives life.

This important and familiar Gospel reading reminds us of the importance of the Eucharist and what it means. The Eucharist is a celebration in which God nourishes us with God's own life. It is a holy and perfect invitation and one which we are all invited to partake in. The Eucharist is our food for life; it nourishes us, providing the sustenance we need in our lives. We give thanks for this and the special invitation that we all have, particularly as we celebrate our children making their First Holy Communion. May they and their families find spiritual sustenance and nourishment through the power of the Holy Eucharist.

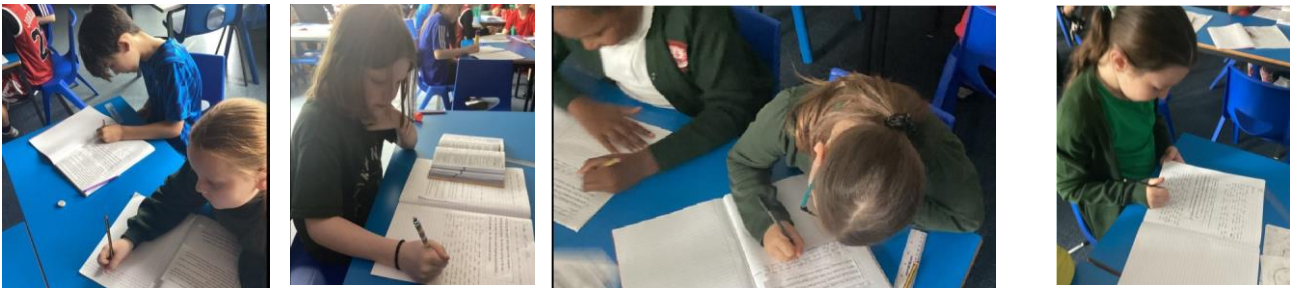




In Sign Language Club, KS1 asked each other questions and signed their names ...

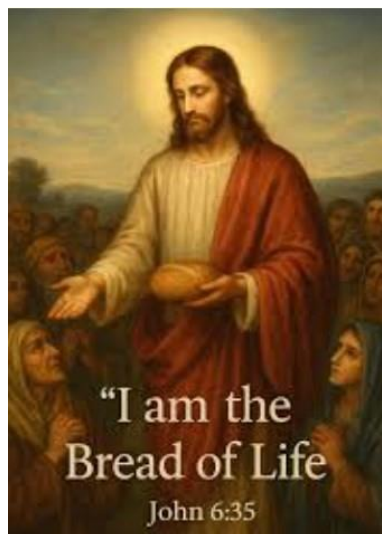
